

# SC&T Scout Environment Camp (ENVS) 2015

Instructions for Leaders

## **ONLINE Registration OPENS 9th of June**

To participate, registration needs to be **received by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> of July**.

Registration requires the following:

- □ Activity Fee of \$20 per Leader for catering (Scouts = \$60)
- □ A signed Activity Participation Form (E1) for each Leader and Scout
- □ A completed **ENVS** EMS Registration (one per group, Leader/PL responsibility)
- □ A printed receipt of the Online Registration, E1s and Money sent to: SC&T HQ, PO Box 200, Port Kembla, 2505

Payment Options:

- <u>Cheque</u> posted with E1s and Registration Receipt Account: Scouts Australia

### Camp Timetable:

The Scout Environment Camp will be held at Mt Keira Scout Camp. Participants need to **arrive and register** at the Mt Keira Wet Weather Shelter **at 6pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> of July.** The camp will conclude at the same location, at **3 pm Sunday the 19<sup>th</sup> of July.** 

### **Patrol Structure:**

Scouts will be placed in patrols for the weekend with other scouts from the region, therefore please indicate if a scout is a PL or APL to assist with the running of the activities.

### **Camp Details:**

Your Scouts will complete their **Cultural Heritage proficiency badge** as well as the 5 'Explore' and 'Reflect' areas of the **World Scout Environment Badge.** They will also get the chance to be part of the first SC&T Youth Environment Forum!

**Major activities include:** Bush Tucker, Water Rocks Geocaching!, Outdoor Cinema, Rainforest Exploration, Construction, design, trivia, eco-games, WSEB ACTION Workshop......And much, much more!

#### Leaders:

Troops must provide at least one adult per two Scout patrols. The camp will function as round robin of activities with the adult helping to assist in the running of the activities. Don't worry, all equipment and the activities will be provided. Scouts are required to nominate a responsible leader who is present for the entire weekend and able to supervise members as required. The leader is not required to be from the same Group.
