Pigskin 2017 – RULES



As defined by the Regional Mindari, for application to the above event.

1. Patrols will consist of a minimum of 4 up to a maximum of 8 Scouts.
2. Each Competitive Patrol will have only one Patrol Leader from Troop lines and only one Assistant Patrol Leader from Troop lines.
3. Each Patrol must be completely self-sufficient. That is, all equipment, food, personal gear, compasses, permanent fine point marker must be carried in appropriately designed backpacks. Good, sound footwear is essential. See E1 form (permission note).
4. Each Patrol must have a pre-written NUTRITIONAL menu and food to suit.
5. Personal gear may be left within the Patrol campsite, day packs with food and drinking water is required to be carried on the course during the day.
6. Upon arrival at the site, Patrol Leaders must report to Administration and provide E1 forms (one per Patrol member), before registration can be completed and campsites assigned.
7. Each Troop represented is encouraged to provide at least one (1) Leader or adult helper to assist in running initiative bases, irrespective of the number of Patrols attending from that Troop.
8. Point scores will be awarded on Patrol performance, camping standards and Patrol Leader performance.
9. Scouts are encouraged to cook on lightweight cooking equipment. **ASSUME A TOTAL FIRE BAN IN THE FOREST.**
10. Upon arrival at each Activity Base, Patrols must book in with the Base Leader and book out prior to departure.
11. Uniforms must be worn to and from the event and at the Closing Parade. Scout Leaders should make provision for appropriate storage of uniforms during the event.
12. Radios GPS devices and other electronic equipment are not permitted for this activity.

Further instructions for patrols will issued at the patrol Leaders Briefing on Saturday at 0800.
