Bengalee Scout Camp is a beautiful bush camp 7.5km north-west of the Shoalhaven River bridge at Nowra. It is available to hire for bush camping or day activities to Scouts and not for profit organisations. Bookings are essential.

On-site at Bengalee Scout camp are female, male and disabled toilets, hot showers, covered dining area, a camp kitchen, bush chapel, town water and electricity.

Whilst here your group can enjoy bushwalking, bird and wildlife watching, orienteering, abseiling, construction, swimming and water activities. Surfing, sailing, hiking, dolphin/whale watching, Trees Adventure Park, Shoalhaven Zoo and the Fleet Air Arm Museum are all a short drive away.
