Position title:	Region Commissioner Water Activities
Primary Purpose:	The Region Commissioner Water Activities has primary responsibility for the successful delivery of the water-based Outdoor Adventure Skills and Special Interest Areas of the Youth Program, including Aquatics, Boating, Paddling and Watersports. This role is also the Region Water Activities Centre Manager.
Reports to:	Deputy Region Commissioner Outdoor Adventure

Tenure:	The appointment is for three years, with Adult Development Plans reviewed annually. Appointments are reviewed regularly (at least every 3 years) and can be extended at 3 yearly intervals, subject to appointment review outcomes.

Position Responsibilities:

In conjunction with the Deputy Region Commissioner Outdoor Adventure, Region Leaders for Water-related Outdoor Adventure Skills and Special Interest Areas, Water Activity Instructors and District Leaders Adventurous Activities; the Region Commissioner Water Activities has responsibility for the planning and successful delivery of the following Water-based Outdoor Adventure Skills and Special Interest Areas:

- Aquatic OAS: Snorkelling, Scuba Diving, Lifesaving, Swiftwater Safety and Surfing.
- · Boating OAS: Sailing and Windsurfing.
- Paddling OAS: Canoeing, Kayaking, Sea Kayaking, White Water Canoeing, White Water Kayaking and White Water Rafting.
- Water Sports SIA: Parasailing, Power Boating, Water Skiing and Wakeboarding.

The Region Commissioner Water Activities is also responsible for:

- Management of the Region Water Activities Centre, including storage, maintenance and coordination of all Water Activities equipment.
- Advise the Deputy Region Commissioner Outdoor Adventure of any risks or issues that may impact water activities within the Region.
- Establish and maintain strong working relationships with District Leaders Adventurous Activities and Activity Instructors.
- Develop an Adult Development Plan (ADP) and review it on an annual basis, in conjunction with the Deputy Region Commissioner Outdoor Adventure.
- Encourage youth leadership and engagement in decision making, particularly with regards to the program experience for Water Activities.
- Measure the Youth Program Experience via feedback from event participants, Region Youth Councils, District Youth Councils, etc.
- Promote youth health, safety, diversity and inclusion for all Water Activities.
- Provide regular communication and social media updates about the details for Region Water Activities and events.
- Uphold the purpose, principles and values of Scouts Australia; adhere to the Adult Code of Conduct and Ethics; comply with all WOSM, National and State policies and behave in accordance with the Scout Promise and Law.
- Comply with all applicable legislative, regulatory and statutory obligations.
- Undertake other projects and responsibilities as negotiated with the Deputy Region Commissioner Outdoor Adventure.

Qualifications, Skills and Experience:

- A strong understanding and commitment to the Aims and Principles of Scouting.
- · Knowledge of the Youth Program.
- Be prepared to complete a Leader of Adults Wood Badge within twelve months of appointment.
- · Enthusiastic and able to motivate, inspire and lead others, both youth and adults.
- · Ability to communicate with all levels in Scouting and the community, including strong interpersonal skills.
- · A commitment to serving young people.
- · Demonstrated organisational and administrative skills.
- Demonstrated ICT skills in relation to communication and data management.
- · The ability to achieve results through collaboration, teamwork and accepting responsibility.
- The ability to work both independently and as a part of a team to achieve goals within set timeframes.
- Qualifications and/or experience in water-related activities, water sports or related fields.
